Continuing legal education

The state's continuing legal education program is now accepting applications for individual courses offered by providers, according to the program's director.

"For providers who choose to accredit their courses one at a time, the process started today," **Karen Litscher Johnson**, the program's director, said in a telephone interview Tuesday.

The Illinois Supreme Court's Minimum Continuing Legal Education Board has accepted applications for accreditation as an approved CLE provider since mid-September. The board has approved nearly 60 applications for accredited provider status, Johnson said.
